## Programme format

**Liberating Leadership** is a two-day residential training programme (all participants are encouraged to stay even if they live locally).

There is a late start and early finish to allow people time to travel to the venue, but the programme does include an evening session on the first day.

The third day is optional - a really useful session to help with 'Putting it into Practice'. You can book the next scheduled date for this session whenever you are ready.

The programme is designed to enable attendees to help individuals and groups recognise and liberate their

leadership potential, by developing their confidence and knowledge so that they:

- have stronger, collective voices
- challenge injustice
- achieve their aims
- play larger roles in how policies and programmes are delivered.

## Liberating Leadership is a fantastic opportunity to develop skills and experience in a new area. The training programme offers:

**FREE Toolkit** - describing the four essential elements of the model, and **including 30 practical participatory exercises** to use with community groups

**Practical content** - tools to explore the concepts of the model
